



The Vermont State Police are investigating the theft of 15 Honda eu2000i generators. Sometime between 09/03/2011 and 09/04/2011, a warehouse in Clarendon, VT which was being utilized by the American Red Cross (ARC), had 15 generators stolen. These generators were slated to assist victims of tropical Storm Irene, who had lost power and were to be used to assist with medical needs.

On 09/11/2011 there were five additional generators stolen from the back of a Budget Auto Rental truck in the parking lot of the American Red Cross building on Strongs Avenue in Rutland City. Rutland Police is investigating that case.
